THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

‘Be wise...think and act in ways that are pleasing to God’, we are advised in the 1st Reading today. As a main objective, as we read in today’s Gospel, **‘we should always be alert and ready to respond favourably to what God wants us to do’**. But we need to remind ourselves that we are not puppets who are controlled by God...we have been given Free Will and are able to decide for ourselves what we will or will not do with our lives. With such freedom goes a great responsibility for the decisions we make and, whilst God is loving, merciful and understanding, he will expect us to decide to live lives of which he will approve. The readings invite us to ask ourselves whether we are always wise and thoughtful in the decisions we take – in all aspects of our lives – and whether we will be able to justify these decisions before God when we are called to account in due course.

Today is Remembrance Sunday, when we reflect on, and give thanks for, the ultimate sacrifice made by so many in the two World Wars and in other conflicts. In particular this year we are celebrating the centenary of the outbreak of hostilities in World War I, when the loss of life was measured in millions...a loss of life which now seems to have been so avoidable, but has contributed in great measure to the freedom we enjoy today. May the souls of all those killed in conflict Rest in Peace and rise in glory.
