Second Sunday of Easter

28th April 2014

Dear friends,

the gospel today tells of Our Lord's first appearance to the disciples on the first Easter Evening. His first word to them was **peace** and their first reaction was **joy**. Peace and joy are the necessary characteristics of Christian living. Their source is the Holy Spirit, the first gift of the Risen Lord to his followers. The Holy Spirit, given also to us, at Baptism and Confirmation equips and empowers us as the community of faith (the Church) for our mission to communicate Jesus and his teaching to others. When we renewed our baptismal promises on Easter Sunday we committed ourselves anew to that task. We are given a description of the very first community of faith in the second reading taken from Acts. We are told that the whole community was i) faithful to the apostles' teaching; ii) that it expressed fellowship; iii) that it prayed; iv) that it broke bread. Two thousand years later those are the continuing signs of the worldwide community of faith that is the Church. We break bread every time we celebrate the Eucharist and in the coming days our children will be initiated into this practice at their First Holy Communion.

Thank you for our Easter celebrations and a special thank you to all those directly involved in their preparation. Although the Easter morning Masses were packed out, attendance on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday were below average. The great vigil of Easter was celebrated in a half empty church. Thank you for your generous Easter offering and for the collection for the Holy Places in Palestine. Deacon Duncan and I have written to the Council expressing disquiet that a number of worshippers on Good Friday afternoon were given parking tickets. We hope that our letter will have an effect.
