Dear friends,

Without a firm foundation many lives are very unstable and some end up with total collapse. As Christians we are called to build our lives upon a sure foundation, Christ our risen Lord. In the second reading today St Peter envisages the Church as a spiritual house of which each Christian is a building block. We are cemented together and are built on Christ. Last week I had occasion to speak about vocations to the ordained ministry. This week it is vital that we also come to the awareness of the priesthood of all the laity with numerous tasks or ministries to fulfil. Jesus is our great High Priest and sharing his life, every Christian shares his priesthood. In St Peter's words we are: a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a consecrated nation, a people set apart to sing the praises of God. As we look at our mundane and often messy lives it is sometimes hard to grasp all this and take it all in. However, Jesus asks us to trust in Him and to trust in the Father. That trust enables us to discern the grace of God at work in us. If we truly believe that Jesus is our way, our truth and our life then we are enabled to communicate the values of his gospel with quiet confidence and unfeigned joy. Baptised and sealed with the Holy Spirit we are empowered to do great things.

Now that our First Holy Communion programme 2014 has been successfully completed I would like to thank again Isobel Barron and the Ryan Family for all their commitment and dedication in what they have achieved for our children.
