### THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

As Fr James completes his week away, basking in the sunshine of the Canary Islands, we reflect in today's readings on the start of Jesus' ministry around the Sea of Galilee 2000 years ago. Now aged about 30, he was already seen as a speaker of great eloquence. We now know that he was to have only three years in which to establish the first group of followers - the apostles - which was to change the accepted norms of life for those who followed him. **He never claimed that following him would be an easy way of life, but he did promise that those who followed him would enjoy eternal life in heaven when they died.**

The accounts of how he drew followers to him are inspirational and we need to keep reminding ourselves that **we too are inspirational in a similar way when we profess our faith in word and deed and stand out in the community as good Christians whose main aim in life is to love God, to love our neighbour and work for the common good.**

We are very grateful to Fr Kieran Dodd for saying Mass for us over this weekend. We trust that a refreshed Fr James will return to us on Monday.
