Dear friends,

the social teaching of the Catholic Church is underpinned by the concept of the **Common Good**. It is a concept that dates back to the earliest days of Christianity and finds full expression in the pages of the New Testament. Today in the excerpt from his letter to the Philippians St Paul exhorts us to work for a common purpose and with a common mind. To this end we have to try and think as Christ thought and to act as he acted. Just as sinfulness is always associated with selfishness, so the common good is at work through the grace of God. Working for the common good almost always entails a sacrifice of one sort or another and the supreme sacrifice was that of our Lord Jesus on the cross. If we are sincere in proclaiming him as Lord then we become ready to relinquish our own interests and desires to help others. The parish as a community of faith will always endeavour to guard against all competitive and divisive influences in order to communicate the values of the gospel both to our neighbourhood and to the wider world.

This weekend seventeen of our children will be enrolled for First Holy Communion and their classes will begin tomorrow Monday 29th September at 5.30pm. Please pray for them, their families and for their catechists.
