Dear friends,

used with care the lovely season of Advent is an antidote to mid winter blues and the brazen clamour of the secular run up to Christmas. The message of Advent is to watch and pray. We try to practise the presence of God who is closer to us than we sometimes realise. The message of Christmas is that God entered our world in human form in the person of our Lord Jesus Christ. He is present to us in the Eucharist and in the Holy Scriptures. He is present to us in the least of his brethren. Many people, who stand at the margins of society, dread this time of year when their sense of loneliness and alienation is heightened. Part of our Advent watchfulness is to recognise them and to meet their needs and respect their dignity in so far as we can. We are told in Scripture that it is more blessed to give than to receive. God grant us all a spirit of generosity as we prepare for Christmas.

This weekend the Rev Jonathan MacNeaney will be ordained as an Anglican priest at St John's, Epping. Pray for him that God may grace his ministry. Continue to pray also for an increase of vocations to our own diocese of Brentwood.
