Dear friends,

the liturgy of the Church is back in Ordinary Time until the beginning of Lent in early March. The response of today's psalm is: **Here I am Lord: I come to do your will.** If we take those words seriously they form a sufficient agenda for Christian living at any time, ordinary or otherwise. The way of the world has always been strongly individualistic and encourages us to do our own thing. The way of Christ is directly contrary to such an attitude. In the agony of the garden Jesus prayed thy will be done and that is the prayer he taught his disciples. The pursuit of self will, whilst it often brings temporary satisfaction, in the long run will always lead to unhappiness. The poet Dante wrote: **in his will is our peace.** To try our best to do what God wants of us is not always easy and requires a lot of self discipline and perseverance but it will always result in a peace of mind surpassing all human understanding.

Tomorrow my brother and I are flying to Las Palmas for a week in search of the sun. It will be my first break from the parish in twelve months. I was last in the Canary Islands in the summer of 1971 when I went there for a month as a young priest to teach English to teenagers.
