Dear friends,

for many people Christianity is thought of as a code of good conduct, an ethical system that promotes neighbourliness and consideration of others. But one doesn't have to be a Christian to be a moral person and an upright human being. Many non believers rightly feel affronted when Christians try to claim the high moral ground. Christianity is a faith, a creed involving certain doctrines foremost of which is belief in God who dwells among us in the person of Jesus Christ, himself truly God and truly man. Christianity proclaims a Redeemer and redemption entails those who are in deliverance from sin and evil. Non doctrinal ethical systems promote therapies of one sort or another in relation to the woes of the world: Christianity proclaims the promise of grace and forgiveness achieved through repentance. Many people want a "feel good" factor in their lives without ever having to recognise that human nature is flawed and what is called for is a total turning to God and a change of heart and mind. Today's scripture says that we are known by our fruits: one of those fruits must be a humble and contrite heart.
