Dear friends,

when a child is baptised a candle is lit from the paschal candle burning next to the font and then given to the parents and godparents on the infant's behalf. The paschal candle itself first lit during the great vigil of Holy Saturday night represents Christ as the Light of the World. At a requiem Mass that same paschal candle burns next to or very near the coffin. Thus, from cradle to grave, a Christian is accompanied by the light of Christ and is called to walk in that light. Today's gospel reminds us that we should display that light openly and proudly. The world all around us is dark and it is cold and cruel. If we allow the divine light to illumine our path, then in some small way our darkened world becomes a little brighter; our cold world becomes a little warmer and our cruel world becomes a little kinder. In the third Mass celebrated on Christmas morning the words of St John are proclaimed: **the light shines in the darkness and the darkness cannot overcome it.** We share Christ's light and in so doing we continue his mission on Earth.
