Dear friends,

This weekend we keep the solemn feast of Saints Peter and Paul. Like St John the Baptist whom we celebrated last Wednesday, they were martyrs and their unswerving witness to Christ is an example to us all. Martyrdom has been a mark of the Church in every age, not least our own. It is our duty at the present time to show solidarity with and to pray for the vulnerable Christians of the Middle East. From earliest times there has been a sizeable Christian community in Mosul and throughout Iraq. They now stand in great peril. Please remember them.

This week we celebrate the 60th anniversary of our Church, the foundation stone of which was officially blessed on 25th June 1954. Ten years ago we had a series of events to mark the golden jubilee: this time round our celebration is more muted but a cake will be cut and coffee served after 11 o'clock Mass. Every parish is a version of the Church in miniature and every parish prospers to the degree that each parishioner is prepared to be involved in its worship and witness.

On Tuesday 1st July the ordination of our new bishop Fr Alan Williams takes place at Brentwood. Please pray for him. A bishop's task is never easy and in an age of religious indifference and militant secularism it is especially difficult. Please pray also for Bishop Thomas McMahon who has served us with such dedication over the past 33 years.

This week I have the pleasure of entertaining my Australian friend Mgr Michael Keating who is dean of St Mary's Cathedral in Perth. We have known each other since 1959. His visit enables me to reciprocate the warm hospitality I have received from him on my numerous visits to Australia.

PETITION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR HEALTH:
