The Feast of Christ the King

Dear friends,

the Feast of Christ the King brings the liturgical year to its conclusion. It is a comparatively recent feast, initiated by Pope Pius XI in the decade after the First World War when totalitarianism was rampant not only in Soviet Russia but also in Germany and Italy with the rise of the Nazis and Facism. Those godless ideologies have now passed into history but the Kingdom of God endures. It is to be discerned not in military might and excessive materialism but in the values of the gospel especially poverty of spirit and hunger and thirst for justice and peace. It is the task of the Church to proclaim the coming of the Kingdom and the duty of every Christian to promote its ideals. The present pope is leading by example. His lifestyle is one of simplicity and in a world of greed and aggression he is encouraging us to follow Jesus who was crowned with thorns and enthroned on a cross. The Kingdom of God is not of this world but it can be found within each of us if we take to heart the message of service and love exemplified in the life and ministry of our blessed Lord.

Next week we begin the season of Advent. Please take a complimentary copy of Walk With Me, a booklet of daily reflections helping us to prepare for Christmas.
