Dear friends,

many people are afraid of being considered old fashioned and will spend a lot of effort and a lot of money desperately trying to keep up with the competitive ways of the world. Today, in the second reading, St Paul pleads with us not to be conformed to the spirit of the aged but to be transformed by the renewal of our minds. Christians must dare to be different and must refuse to go with the flow and to do this requires a lot of courage. The same point is made powerfully in the gospel where our Lord tells his followers that they are to have a share in his cross. What profit is there, he says, in gaining the whole world if one makes a mess of life in the process? The choice is stark: conformity with a secular life style or transformation through the gift of God's grace.

Fr Andrew Hurley's body will be received into St Helen's Church, Ongar on Tuesday 2nd September with Mass at 7.30pm. The funeral will take place at Brentwood Cathedral on Wednesday 3rd September at 12 noon followed by burial in Southend. After the funeral I shall leave for a holiday break in the Lake District returning on Friday 12th September.

ASSISTED DYING/EUTHANASIA: As you may be aware there is to be yet another attempt to change the law of our country to allow Assisted Dying, which is tied up with Euthanasia. The Catholic Church abhors any meddling with the sanctity of human life from conception to NATURAL death. We need to make our principles clear to our MP and ask her to vote against the introduction of legislation which would make Assisted Dying/Euthanasia legal. There are copies, at the back of the church, of a comprehensive and quite frightening speech by Lord Alton of Liverpool, which sets out the argument and reasons for rejecting moves to make Assisted Dying/Euthanasia legal. Please read the speech, and, if you feel able, write to Eleanor Laing, MP for Epping Forest to ask her to vote against the motion.
