The Baptism of the Lord

Sunday 12th January 2014

Dear friends,

the Baptism of the Lord, which we keep today, complements last week's celebration of the Epiphany in as much as it is a further revelation of Jesus as the Beloved Son. It is of immense significance given that all four gospels refer to it whereas the nativity of the Lord is only mentioned by two of them. John the Baptist was rightly taken aback when Jesus sought baptism from him since baptism was for the remission of sin. Jesus, Son of God, is without sin. Nevertheless in undergoing baptism he wished to show solidarity with the whole human race that he had come to redeem. Baptism is a movement of the Holy Spirit and the same Holy Spirit empowered Jesus for his ministry of preaching and of healing. For us baptism signifies our sharing in the life and ministry of Christ and makes us out as his disciples. An alternative word for Baptism is Christening and Christians are those who are proud to follow Christ. In choosing godparents for their children parents should ensure that such sponsors are themselves men and women of sound Christian conviction and commitment, worthy role models of Christian life who have been baptised themselves. Today gives us all an opportunity to renew the high promises of our own baptism, renouncing all that is alien to him and professing once again our faith in the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
