**Sunday 2nd March 2014**

Dear friends,

the season of Lent is almost upon us. Wednesday next, 5th March, is Ash Wednesday when there will be Mass at 10am and 8pm. The simple ceremony of imposing a cross of ashes on our foreheads is a sober reminder to us of the transience of all earthly things. We hear the words: *remember that you are dust and to dust you will return*. The gospel we hear today is taken from Our Lord's sermon on the Mount and urges us to think about our priorities and values. A proper perspective will be given to us if we place all things in the light of eternity. We have here no ordinary abiding city: we seek for one which is to come. If we seek first for the Kingdom of God everything else will assume its proper place. Whatever observances we choose to mark it the Lenten season is intended to concentrate our minds on what is really important in life and to help us to see that some things matter more than others. During Lent, at the suggestion of the Parish Council, the weekday Mass, beginning from Monday 10th March, will start at 9.15am instead of 9am. In this way it is hoped that, once the school run is over, parents may have the opportunity of getting to Mass on a weekday in Lent. As is customary there will be Stations of the Cross at 6pm every Sunday during Lent.
