Third Sunday of Lent

23rd March 2014

Dear friends,

for the next three Sundays the gospel will be a lengthy excerpt from St John, beginning today with our Lord's encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well. Their conversation is about thirst which she perceives simply at the physical level. Very gently Jesus leads her to consider thirst of a deeper dimension: thirst for God and things of the Spirit. Jesus speaks of those who worship "in Spirit and in truth". Time and again in scripture we are warned against worship that is little more than lip service and mechanical ritual, going through the motions without any real engagement of the heart and mind. Indeed in the psalm today we hear the words "harden not your hearts." In the second reading St Paul writing to the Romans says that the Holy Spirit is the guarantee of sincere and genuine worship and when we do not know how to pray as we ought the Spirit within us makes good our deficiencies. Frequent invocation of the Holy Spirit with words like **come Holy Spirit** will invigorate our prayer and our worship and maintain in us a thirst for the things of God.

Tuesday next, March 25th, is the feast of the Annunciation. It was encouraging to have good congregations last week for St Patrick and St Joseph. I hope that Lady Day as the Annunciation is sometimes called will also have a good attendance.
